Recruitment Schedule & Overview

Primary Recruitment at UNM is a multi-day process where you'll meet each of our participating Panhellenic chapters.

Recruitment Schedule:

Recruitment Dates and Times for 2025

- Day One - Philanthropy - August 22nd, 4:00 pm-9:30 pm
- Day Two - Sisterhood & Finances - August 23rd, 3:00 pm-7:00 pm
- Day Three - Preference - August 24th, 3:30 pm-7:30 pm
- Day Four - BID DAY! Details to be announced.

*Times subject to change.

Recruitment Rounds: Each recruitment day has a theme, such as Philanthropy Round, where chapters will share the causes and service initiatives they support. You'll engage in conversations with current members to learn about chapter values and experiences.

Recruitment Orientation: You'll be matched with a Recruitment Counselor (Rho Gamma) to guide and support you throughout the process.

Membership Recruitment Acceptance Binding Agreement (MRABA)

At the end of recruitment, all PNMs will be asked to sign the MRABA, which is a required document for receiving and accepting a bid from an NPC sorority.

Key Considerations

Time Commitments:

Recruitment and new membership include several required events:

During Recruitment:
Recruitment Orientation, Daily attendance at recruitment rounds and events.

As a New Member: Weekly new member meetings and chapter meetings, Programs, philanthropy events, and service opportunities, Occasional weekend or evening commitments.

Each chapter may vary slightly, but we'll help you plan ahead!

Financial Information:

Each chapter has its own financial structure, which will be explained during recruitment.

Chapters will share their dues, fees, and payment schedules during the second round. Fees often cover chapter events, sisterhood activities, apparel, and national dues. Financial transparency documents will be made available to you in advance to help with your decision-making.

Academic Expectations:

Academics are a priority in all our Panhellenic organizations.

While there is no GPA requirement to register, each chapter sets its own academic standards for membership. Chapters will share GPA expectations during recruitment. Many offer tutoring, study hours, and academic mentoring.

Housing (If Applicable): Some UNM chapters may offer housing or have housing expectations. If applicable, you'll learn about housing opportunities and future commitments during recruitment. Most housing is not available until your second year or later.
